HOW STUDENTS CAN HELP

Type of Risk	How You Can Be Involved
Strategic	Give feedback in surveys about college direction and course relevance.
Operational	Report broken equipment, timetable, or classroom issues.
Compliance	Report misconduct, academic honesty, or safety concerns.
Reputational	Use social media responsibly and participate in positive outreach.
Technical	Report phishing attempts or LMS / portal problems.
